



# Newly Confirmed Cases Marion County, Oct 11 - Nov 6 2020





# ED Visits with COVID-19 Symptoms Marion County, Oct 11 - Nov 10 2020





# 1st-time Hospital Admissions for Persons with COVID-19 Positive Lab. Test Marion County, Oct 11 - Nov 7 2020





# Deaths Marion County, Oct 11 - Nov 6 2020






# Age Distribution of confirmed COVID-19 cases by month, Marion County, IN, Mar 1 - Oct 31 2020


# New Cases per 100,000 persons by Age Group

# Public Health Order #35

- Effective Monday, Nov. 16<sup>th</sup> at 12am
- Bars return to 25% indoor capacity with 100% outdoor capacity
- Restaurants remain at 50%
- Outdoor tents must be only two sided
- Live Entertainment and Music Venues must be cleared of all patrons from 12am to 5am

# Public Health Order #35

- Gyms and Fitness Centers return to 25% capacity
- Assisted living may allow indoor visitation if a person has a negative test in last 72 hours
- Tables must return to seating only 6
- Funeral homes must return to 50% capacity
- Social gatherings limited to 25 people

# School Public Health Issues

- No later than November 30<sup>th</sup>, 2020, Schools will be required to return to virtual instruction
  - All schools can go virtual prior
  - This includes all grades K to 12
- Beginning November 30<sup>th</sup>, 2020, K-12 School Extra Curricular Activities and Sporting Events can only include participants, their parents, or guardians, and support personnel
- Order ends on January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021
